January 5, 2015 - Four judges will represent Canada at the <u>2015 WBTF International Cup</u> [1] in Abbotsford, Canada. Joining Ron Kopas (CBTF Judges' Rep) will be Larissa Dearing, Natalie Fehres and Amy Genton.

The CBTF Board extends its thanks to this group for the thought and consideration they exercised while determining this judging panel.
