GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Participants make cheque or money order payable to your clubs name and clubs will submit one payment and entries payable to **BATON NEW BRUNSWICK**. NO REFUNDS WITHOUT MEDICAL CERTIFICATE.

- 2. Deadline for entries Friday April 19, 2019. Entries received between April 20, 2019 and April 22, 2019 will be assessed a \$20 late fee. No entries will be accepted after April 22, 2019.
- 3. Current CBTF rules and regulations will be in effect and strictly enforced. All questions are to be asked directly to the **Competition Director.** Judges may not be approached at any time. Judges decisions are final. Results are considered official forty-eight (48) hours after the end of competition. The set system and the flash card system will be implemented.
- 4. All athletes must be a registered member in good standing of CBTF for the 2018-2019 competition season. In order for an athlete/group to compete in a CBTF sanctioned competition, all athletes must be coached by a currently registered CBTF certified (minimum) Level 2 Coach (Competitive). Divisions will be offered for special needs athletes if required.
- 5. All athletes must declare any medical support/brace worn for the prevention of injury as deemed necessary by a physician. A copy of a medical certificate or a paper signed by a physician must accompany entry.
- 6. <u>CBTF risk management policy</u>: a) The Competition Director or designate will have the authority to immediately stop the competition whenever a risk factor related to safety becomes evident. If this situation occurs during individual competition, the competition on the lane where the situation occurs will be stopped (on that lane only). If an athlete has to leave the competition to seek outside medical assistance because of a situation that has occurred during a competition, they will require a medical certificate in order to continue competing.
- 7. **No Flash Photography Allowed**. Turn the flash off if you are taking photographs within the gymnasium. Photos and videos can be taken from stands only.
- 8. **Awards Pre-Competitive Program events:** ribbons. **Pre-Competitive Twirler:** must enter 3 pre competitive events to qualify. (example) L1= athlete enters two L1 or more and one L2 event. L2=athlete enters two L2 or more and one L1 events 1st -3rd awards. **Graded individual/group events:** CBTF graded medals. **Open Events** 1st 3rd place medals. **Individual and Duet Winner/Championship Events:** 1st 5th place medals. **Group Events:** 1st 3rd place medals.
- 9. Athletes will compete at their age as of midnight December 31st, 2018. Age category: 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18+. Ages may be combined or split as entries warrant according to CBTF rules, in no case will a division be run with ages combined beyond these limits. Duet Twirl: combined ages of both athletes determine age division: 17-22, 23-28, 29-34, 35+.
- 10. **Team/Freestyle/Pairs Music** IPOD technology will be used. Please ensure that Brenda (<u>batonatlantik@gmail.com</u>) has received your music to load onto the IPod by April 19, 2019 and the CBTF protocol for music labelling music must be used. You must have a backup copy of your competition music available on an IPod or other MP3 player.
- 11. **Athletes Gym Fee** All participating athletes will be required to pay a gym fee with entry. Each athlete will receive unlimited free admission for family & friends and a program.
- 12. **Groups** (coaches or club directors) must submit a group roster with their competition entry. The roster needs to include group athletes' names, membership numbers, and age as of December 31, 2018. CBTF group status levels are determined as per current CBTF rules. Age divisions are determined by average age of members as of December 31, 2018. Juvenile 7.0-11.9999, Junior 12.0-14.9999 and Senior 15.0 and over.
- 13. **Processionals and Awards Ceremonies** all athletes are asked to be in costume or club track suits for processionals and awards ceremonies. CLUB TRACKSUIT must be worn properly (i.e. jacket zipped, non-rolled pants or sleeves), or COSTUME (no t-shirts, shorts or any extra clothing). Athletes must be wearing baton shoes. ABSOLUTELY NO STREET SHOES ALLOWED.
- 14. Qualifying for Canadian Championships Individual/Duet Level A, BA, BI, BN: top 5 in each division, any athlete who attains a minimum score of 2.5 for Level BN 3.50 for Level BI 5.0 for Level BA 7.0 for Level A. Freestyle/Pair qualification for B/A level Canadian Championships: athlete(s) must attain a minimum net score of 25 (after penalties) for level B & 40 (after penalties) for level A at provincials, in order to qualify for Canadians.
