General Information

1. All Current CBTF rules and Regulations will be in effect and enforced.
2. Judges Decisions are final
3. Competition Director reserves the right to make any changes to the competition to facilitate continuity to the day. Note this is not an actual competition as there will be no scoring.
4. All athletes and coaches must be current, registered members, in good standing with OBTA/CBTF
5. Awards – there will be no actual awards as there is no competition. There will be a participation “gift” for each athlete attending.
6. Breakfast and Lunch will be served all day in the Cafeteria
7. First Aid will be there on site.
8. Warm up area will be available as well as a special needs lane upon request
9. Set System will be e mailed out to coaches prior to the competition
- 10 All athletes must declare any medical support or brace worn for the prevention of injury as deemed necessary by a physician. Copy of Medical certificate must accompany entry.
- 10.Comment Tapes will be used for Freestyle. Please see competition director in the morning of the competition to hand them in.
11. Explanation of the day!
After the athlete completes their performance, the athlete or coach may approach the judge for a brief verbal summary of the program. At this time the judge will give any comments he/she feels could help with the success of the routine in the future. This is a brief discussion. If the athlete/or coach does not want to participate in the verbal summary there will be a critique sheet that will be filled out to take home by the judge. For Freestyles the coach can sit directly with the judge while the athlete is performing or hand in a tape. All direction will have a positive focus!

13. RIBBON, BADGE OR PIN, IF SUCCESSFUL, WILL BE GIVEN AT THE COMPLETION OF THE TEST.
