

CBTF Annual General Meeting

June 30, 2009 - On Tuesday, June 30, the Canadian Baton Twirling Federation conducted the Annual General Meeting for its members. The meeting was held in Edmonton, Alberta, during the Canadian Baton Twirling Championships.

Ballots will be sent out by mail - CBTF athletes should watch for their ballot in their Canada Post mailbox. Voting will remain open until July 30, 2009 - ballots must be received on/before that date to be valid.

Ron Kopas has been nominated for the position of Judges' Representative. Voting for Judges' Representative will be conducted online, using the cbtf.ca website. All CBTF-registered judges are eligible to vote. Judges will have to log in to the website using their personal username/password in order to record their vote.
