#### **ENTRIES:**

 Cheques/e-transfers from individuals will NOT be accepted. Payment for all athletes belonging to a club must be made by ONE CLUB CHEQUE or ONE EMAIL TRANSFER that will cover all team, individual entries and gym fees.

<u>NSF Cheques</u> will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge. Cheque amount and service charge must be paid by cash or certified cheque no later than 1 week prior to the event.

- 2. If you wish for a confirmation that your entry form has been received or if you have any questions, please e-mail competition director within ample time to resolve if it was not received.
- 3. Refunds given only if an athlete is unable to compete and a medical certificate must be provided to Competition Director. If a Bye to Nationals is granted, no refund will be given.
- 4. Any entries received after April 13, 2020 will be returned. **ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- 5. Admission included on entry form NO FEE WILL BE PAYABLE AT DOOR
- 6. Set system will be provided to each registered club for their own distribution. Each dressing room and main entrances to gym will have the set system displayed.

#### AMENITIES:

- 1. Medical assistance, Warm-up area will be available on site. Only athletes still to compete, and Minimum L1 currently registered coaches will be allowed in warm up area. Absolutely no parents, adults, or non-competing children in the area.
- 2. A special needs lane will be made available, upon request.
- 3. Concession: Lunch and other refreshments will be available on site by CBSO and the local Non-Profit coffee shop. Please support CBSO and the "Petit Café de Cantley".
- 4. First aid will be available on site

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- 5. Current CBTF Rules and Regulations will be in effect and strictly enforced.
- 6. CBTF Risk Management Policy
  - A. The Competition Director or designate and/or the Head Judge shall have the authority to immediately stop the competition whenever a risk factor related to safety becomes evident.
  - B. If this situation occurs during individual competition, the competition on the lane where the situation occurs shall be stopped on that lane only by the competition director and/or the judge judging that event.
  - C. If an athlete must leave the competition to seek outside medical assistance because of a situation that has occurred during a competition, the athlete shall require a Medical Certificate stating that he/she may continue competing at that competition.
  - D. If the situation involves a medical injury or illness (that does not require outside medical assistance), the Competition Director, in consultation with authorized medical personnel, shall determine whether the athlete(s) may be allowed to continue competing.
- 7. Judges decisions are final. Tabulated results are final 48 hours after the completion of the competition day.
- 8. Obvious errors or omissions will be corrected by email from the Competition Director.
- 9. Clerks and Runners are to report 15 minutes prior to the start of the competition on Saturday for instructions and be available when required. Clerks and Runners must dress appropriately, in a non-partisan manner (i.e.: no club jackets).
- 10. Athletes entering the open pre-competitive and competitive events must be currently registered type A, B and/or G members. The CBTF membership number must be indicated on the entry form.
- 11. In order for an athlete/group to compete in a CBTF sanctioned competition, all athletes must be coached by a currently registered CBTF certified Level 2 Coach.
- 12. Athlete/Group must declare any medical support/brace necessary for injury prevention as deemed necessary by a physician. Copy of medical certificate must accompany entry or be presented to the Competition Director prior to the start of the competition.
- 13. Competition director reserves the right to divide or combine age divisions as entries warrant, but the broadest divisions to be used will be 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18+

Note: the minimum age to compete (individual events, duet and teams) remains at 7 years Note: Athletes as young as 4 years of age may participate in pre-competitive events

14. Order of events:

Pompom Teams, Dance Twirl Teams, Twirl Teams, Freestyle Team, WBTF Group, Precompetitive Groups, Performance group, Freestyle, Pair Short Program, Compulsory Moves, Basic, Forward Motion, Medley, Solo Dance, Solo & Duet, 2 baton, 3 baton. Pre-Events will precede the full event it represents.

Competition Director reserves the right to make last minute changes to facilitate movement of the day.

Club Directors will be notified as soon as possible of any changes.

- 15. All music in its **FINAL** form must be submitted to Lisa Pitre, in MP3 or MP4 with correct file labelling format by **April 23rd**, **2020**. No revisions will be accepted after this date. Music may be emailed to <a href="mailto:cbso@live.ca">cbso@live.ca</a>
- 16. A tentative line-up for Group events will be e-mailed to the Club Directors. Club Directors must advise the competition director of any errors or conflicts within deadline established by FQBS. The list will remain as printed without further changes after this date.
- 17. Flashing: subject to CBTF rules, all athletes in graded system will not have scores flashed. All other scores will be flashed.
- 18. There will be one (1) run through of the music for each CBTF individual event.
- 19. As per CBTF rules, all athletes in Level C or BN up to and including 11 years of age will be evaluated under the CBTF grading system and receive CBTF graded medals and have one judge, one round.
- 20. Gym fee of \$6.00 for all athletes and must be paid by the club. Please complete "club entry reconciliation".
- 21. AWARDS: All OPEN events will be posted and awards will be available for pick up at awards table. Graded individual events and pre-competitive event results will be available for pick up at awards table.

Groups and individuals – 1st to 3rd: Ribbons GRADING SYSTEM: Please note that all athletes in C and BN divisions from 7 – 11 years of age inclusive AND Level C Primary and Juvenile groups (all types of groups or teams) are evaluated under the CBTF Grading system (Diamond, Gold, Silver, Bronze) and are not scored, or placed. All athletes receive a medal commensurate with the level they are graded at (Diamond, Gold, Silver, Bronze) PRE-EVENT athletes/teams are also GRADED, and will receive ribbons commensurate with the grade they attain.
