The competition sound system *may* be available for use during the paid practice time. Personal sound systems may be used, but only to the extent they don't interfere with other participants.

Athlete Bags:

Please visit the Registration Table prior to your first scheduled practice time to pick up your Athlete Bag, ID Tag and Souvenir Program.

Gymnasium Footwear:

Outdoor shoes are NOT allowed in the competition gym at any time. Athletes should wear indoor shoes only.

Change Rooms:

The change room area is very small, so please do not bring large rack and roll type bags. The change room area is the shared team room bathroom behind the practice gym. We do not have access to the team rooms for this event, like in previous years as the university teams are still competing. The U of R team athletes may also be in and out of the change room area as well, so please do not block off access to the sinks, toilets, etc. and do not leave valuables in the change room. This area should really only be used for changing costumes and fixing hair and makeup. Athletes are expected to keep this area clean and tidy. If the change room is found to be in poor condition, the competition staff may assess a cleaning fee.

Spectators:

Spectators will access the seating area through the spectator entrance. Spectators are NOT allowed onto the competition gym floor or the practice gym floor.

Parking:

U of R Parking - parking is free in the lot directly in front of the CKHS (Lot 6) Friday after 5:00 pm and all weekend. (Parking is not free in the parkade - payment is required at all times to park in the parkade.)

Parking during the day Friday and Monday can be at the meters in front of the CKHS building for \$2.00/hr or in the parkade at \$3.50/hr. These are pay as you go, no passes are available.

Merchandise:

Merchandise pre-orders will be available for pick up with the registration packages. Soles and Suits will be on-site as well and may have very limited event wear items for purchase as well. If you are still interested in pre-ordering merchandise, there may be some availability to add purchases to the pre-order. Please email Nancy Lightheart at lightheart@myaccess.ca if you are still interested in placing an order.

There will also be a small number of vendors on-site on Saturday, March 9 that will be selling various items including jewelry, dancewear and other baton related items.

Banners:

If you have a banner to be displayed (club or provincial), please leave it at the registration desk. The host committee will place or hang banners to comply with the facility requirements. At the end of the competition, the host committee will remove the banners and they will be available for pick up from the announcers table. Hanging banners will only be accepted if they have grommet holes.

Opening Ceremony:

All participants (athletes, coaches, dignitaries) are asked to report backstage (in the Practice Gym) at 6:15 pm. The Opening Ceremony will begin at 6:30 pm on Friday, March 8.

CTT and NLCO Athletes in the opening ceremonies should be dressed in Track Suits (Club or Provincial).

Regina Cable TV:

Athletes, coaches, judges, officials and spectators should be aware of the possibility of multiple cameras and TV crew onsite throughout the weekend. It is also possible that CBTF may be asked to supply commentators for the broadcast, in which case athletes will be asked to complete an information sheet that will be provided to the commentators. Baton Documentary:

We are currently working on details for the filming of part of a baton documentary during the Canadian Team Trials. This will involve behind-the-scenes film footage in the practice gym. More details will follow as they become available. Consent will be obtained from those who will be involved in the documentary.

Awards Ceremony:

The Awards Ceremony for the NLCO is scheduled to begin at 5:30 pm on Saturday, shortly after the completion of the competition. The start time will be adjusted according to the progress of other events during the day - please pay attention to announcements.

All athletes that participated in the NLCO will be included in the Awards Ceremony. Athletes should be in costume. The order of presentation will be:

- Freestyle Pair
- Freestyle Team
- Freestyle Solo

The Awards Ceremony for the CTT is scheduled to begin at 11:30 am on Sunday, shortly after the completion of the competition. The start time will be adjusted according to the progress of other events during the day - please pay attention to announcements.
