General Information:

The Glitter and Gold Competition aims to provide a fun, relaxed first competition of the year for the athletes heading into a new competition season. This competition allows for critiques for Groups/Teams and the option to do critiques for individual and competitive events to fun, chart-topping music. This provides the opportunity to gain feedback on routines still in progress without the stress of scores or placements. The purpose is to provide a relaxed atmosphere in a competition setting. This will also allow for the opportunity for new twirlers to see how a competition works. COSTUMES ARE RECOMMENDED BUT NOT REQUIRED.

Practice Area and Medical Personnel on site.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

TYPE A - Athlete can enter all events.

TYPE B - Athlete can enter all Pre-Competitive events.

TYPE G - Athlete can enter all group events.

All athletes and their coaches must be registered, current members, in good standing of their own provincial organization and the CBTF. In order to compete, athletes must be coached by a certified L2 registered coach.

Music Notes:

- Athletes performing Solo, Duet, 2-Baton and/or 3-Baton for critiques only will perform to fun, chart-topping music.
- 烤 Junior, Senior and Collegiate athletes in Solo Dance Twirl will perform to the WBTF Artistic Twirl music selection.
- Primary and Juvenile athletes will perform to the designated Solo Dance Twirl music Selection 2.
- BA and A athletes may use extended time limits for Solo and 2-Baton Music.

Music Requirements:

- All music must be submitted to the contact email electronically.
- Music must be submitted no later than January 14th, 2023.
- Each file should be clearly labelled following the CBTF music labelling protocol.

Awards:

- Pre-Competitive Events CBTF Ribbons
- Critique Only Events Specialty Ribbons
- Competitive Individual Events Medallions
- Skills Development Program CBTF Ribbons, Badges and Pins
- Specialty Awards will be handed out throughout the day.

Score sheets for all Individual events will be available at the Awards Table. Results for Competitive events will be posted.

CBTF SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM:

Adjudication for the Canadian Baton Twirling Skills Development Program will be offered. Athletes can be tested on Yellow Badge, Orange Badge, Red Badge Maroon Badge, Bronze Pin, Bronze Rolls Badge, Bronze 2-Baton Badge, Grey Badge, Green Badge, Turquoise Badge, Pink Badge, Silver Pin, Silver 2-Baton Badge, Silver Rolls Badge, Purple Badge, Blue Badge, Gold Pin, Gold 2-Baton Badge, Gold Rolls Badge, Copper Badge, Diamond Pin, Black Badge, Maple Leaf Pin.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

The Team, Compulsory/Short Program, Freestyle, and Pair events are CRITIQUE ONLY EVENTS.

Open Competition:

Effective January 1, 2019 the CBTF Competitive Program will consist of 5 levels - C, BN, BI, BA, and A.

The advancement scores (Net Score, after penalty deductions) for each level are:

Level C to BN: 2.50 Level BN to BI: 3.50 Level BI to BA: 5.00 Level BA to A: 7.00

CBTF GRADING SYSTEM

To follow the CBTF Long Development Model the evaluation for Primary and Juvenile Athletes the score determined by the judge will translate to a rating of Bronze, Silver, Gold or Diamond. Every competing athlete will earn a medal for their performance.

 0.5 - 1.5 = Bronze 2.5 - 3.0 = Bronze

 1.6 - 2.1 = Silver 3.1 - 3.6 = Silver

 2.2 - 2.4 = Gold 3.7 - 3.9 = Gold

 2.5 + E = Diamond 4.0 + E = Diamond

Refund Policy:

Refunds will only be given for withdrawal from the competition for medical reasons. A medical certificate must be provided in order to receive refund.

NOTE:

Athlete's wearing tensor bandages, etc. at the competition are asked to provide a medical certificate PRIOR TO COMPETITION stating that the athlete can participate in the competition event. The Competition Director (in consultation with the Head Judge) has the authority to refuse to allow an athlete to compete if medical certificate is not provided.

ERRORS or OMISSIONS on entry form will be corrected via email to the entrant.

SPLITTING OF SINGLE AGE DIVISIONS - If there are 16 or more athletes competing in a single age division, the Competition Director will split divisions as deemed necessary. Groups will be split by age.

CBTF RISK MANAGMENTPOLICY

- 1. The Competition Director or Designate and/or the Head Judge will have the authority to stop the competition whenever a risk factor related to safety becomes evident.
- 2. If this situation occurs during individual competition, the competition on the lane where the situation occurs shall be stopped on that lane only by the Competition Director and/or the judge judging the event.
- 3. If the situation involves a medical injury or illness, the Competition Director in consultation with authorized medical personnel, shall determine whether the athlete(s) may be allowed to continue competing. The CBTF Risk Management Policy requires that a medical certificate is obtained before the athlete(s) is/are allowed to continue competing at that competition.

SCORES WILL BE FLASHED FOR OPEN COMPETITIVE EVENTS.

With the exception of graded events and critique only events. Scores will be flashed before penalties have been subtracted.

CANADIAN BATON TWIRLING FEDERATION (CBTF) RULES AND REGULATIONS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023 WILL BE IN EFFECT AND STRICTLY ENFORCED.

JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

TABULATION RESULTS ARE CONSIDERED 48 HOURS AFTER ANNOUNCEMENT OR POSTING.

Volunteers

Volunteer Job Descriptions:

- ★ TABULATION Responsible for the accurate tabulation and record-keeping of the competitive event results.
- AWARDS Distribute score sheets and awards.
- RUNNERS Responsible to pick up score sheets from the judges' tables and deliver them to Tabulation/Awards. Run water/refreshments to the judges and clerks.
- **WELCOME TABLE** Act as a greeter and ensure that programs/set systems are picked up by the athletes.
- **SOUND/MUSIC** Playing of the CBTF Music and the various music for teams, freestyles, pairs, etc.
- FIRST AID PERSONNEL It is mandatory to have qualified medical personnel whose qualifications include current Standard First Aid Level and CPR. This may include handing out ice packs, bandages, taping etc.
- SET UP COMMITTEE Includes moving tables, chairs, equipment and decorating.
- CLEAN UP COMMITTEE Check all areas for lost and found items as well as take down of equipment at the end of the day.
- FLOOR MONITOR Ensure a safe number of athletes are using the designated practice area.
- X QUADRANT MONITOR Ensure athletes are ready and at their lane for their set.
- CLERKS Assisting the judges in writing down comments etc. on athletes score sheets. You will be sitting with the judges. Parents or relatives cannot clerk their own child/relative.
- MERCHANDISE TABLE Selling and distributing merchandise.
