### **Voltage Converter Needed in England**

In England the standard voltage is 230 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. You can't use your electric appliances (including hair dryer, hair straighteners, etc.) without a voltage converter because the standard voltage in England (230 V) is higher than in Canada (120 V).

**ENGLAND USES THE POUND STERLING.** Visa and Mastercard Credit cards are widely accepted in England, although small corner stores may only accept cash. Canadian debit cards can be used at ATMs to get cash but aren't accepted for purchases. It is always recommended to have a small amount of local currency upon arrival in a new country until you can find an ATM machine.

This package is designed for the World Championship athlete, coach, official and chaperone.

Also note - breakfast is included with the daily price of your hotel room. We are attempting to negotiate an evening meal at the hotel so the daily hotel cost may increase.

Average temperature in August range from 13 - 19 degrees but in 2022 there were some August days that reached 29 degrees.

### 1. Getting to Nations Cup and the World Championships

All coaches, team managers and athletes are asked to arrive in Liverpool by August 1<sup>st</sup> for those competing at Nations Cup and by August 5<sup>th</sup> for those competing only at the World Championship. Those who are only competing at Nations Cup are free to leave on August 9<sup>th</sup> and those competing in the World Championship are free to leave on August 14<sup>th</sup>.

Parents and other spectators may arrive at any time, bearing in mind the Opening Ceremony for Nations Cup is August 4<sup>th</sup> and the Opening Ceremony for the World Championships is August 9<sup>th</sup>.

### 2. At the Nations Cup and World Championships

Upon arrival at the hotel, the hotel may require a credit card for any incidental charges associated with your room. Your room is not guaranteed until check-in – early check-in is not guaranteed. When staying at the hotel chosen for the contingent, as part of the contingent, do not expect to pay the same price as an online advertised price. The group bookings carry different costs.

A **Breakfast Buffet** is included at the hotel. Lunches will be pre-arranged for practice days. Bring an insulated lunch bag and water bottle with you.

On August 8th the final Secret Pal gifts will be exchanged and after the awards athletes will attend the **Athletes Party**, which is walkable following the awards.

The **Canadian Contingent Welcome Reception** will be held on August 3<sup>rd</sup> (tentative). This event is mandatory for athletes, coaches and officials.

All Athletes, Officials and Coaches will receive an Official World Champion Program with their credentials package.

As in previous years, an **International Twirl Nations Clinic** will be held in conjunction with the competition. Attendance is strongly recommended. *More information to come soon!* 

### 3. Completing the Forms

The Contingent Package consists of two forms:

- 1. **Traveler Payment Form** Each contingent traveler (athlete, coach, chaperone, team manager, judge, official), adult or child, must complete this Traveler Payment Form.
- 2. **Hotel Worksheet** Each group of travelers staying together should complete a single Hotel Room Worksheet. This Worksheet is used to calculate the 'per person' hotel cost, which is transferred to the Traveler Payment Form.

After May 22, 2023, you are financially responsible for all components selected in your package. There will be NO refunds for any hotel cancellations after May 22, 2023.

All payment amounts on these forms are estimates. CBTF purchases the products and services in advance on behalf of all travelers and then applies the money received from the travelers. **Due to the uncertainties caused by fluctuation in costs, you may be required to pay additional costs once we return from England and all charges have been incurred and converted to Canadian Dollars.**

### **Travel Insurance**

This is a reminder that provincial health plans do not cover out of country travel and it is always good practice to ensure you have out of country coverage, whether through an employer, school or private health plan.

ATHLETES AND COACHES WILL BE ISSUED BADGES FOR WHATEVER COMPETITION THEY ARE ENTERED IN (NATIONS CUP AND/OR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP). YOU WILL NEED THE BADGE TO ACCESS THE PRACTICE GYMS FOR YOUR PARTICULAR COMPETITION. THE BADGES WILL ALLOW <u>ATHLETES</u> TO GO TO BOTH COMPETITIONS AS SPECTATORS ON THE DAYS THEY ARE NOT COMPETING.

### **Hotel Worksheet**

Complete one Hotel Room Worksheet per room. The form does not have to be duplicated for each guest – simply copy the 'Per Person Hotel Cost' calculated at the bottom of the page to each guest's Payment Form.

Remember that the rooms can easily accommodate 1 or 2 guests.

Enter the names of your roommate and select the appropriate rate for your occupancy – Single, Double.

Divide the Total Hotel Cost by the Occupancy to determine the Per Person Hotel Cost. The Per Person Hotel Cost is copied to each Traveler's Payment Form.

Complete one Package Payment Form per traveler (adult or child).

All required forms including: Document & Information Checklist, Athlete Health Information Sheet, Secret Pal Sheet, CBTF Code of Conduct, Traveler Payment Form and Hotel Room Worksheet can be submitted online in advance of May 22nd to Sue Mepham at: <a href="mailto:office@cbtf.ca">office@cbtf.ca</a>. This will speed up the process at the Contingent Clinic, as processing all of the paperwork can take a few hours, and longer if there is missing information. You can also etransfer the \$1,000 per person deposit in advance to Terry Stewart at: <a href="mailto:treasurer@cbtf.ca">treasurer@cbtf.ca</a> and indicate that on your Traveler Payment Form. Please clearly indicate the traveler's name on each etransfer.

In the event that you are paying by cheque, it must be made payable to "CBTF Inc" and handed directly to Joanne Moser at the Contingent Meeting on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.
